CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

As a player for the Manteca Youth Softball Association, I agree to:

- **Respect my Manager/Coach.** The Manager/Coach is a volunteer who donates his/her time to MYSA. It is my duty to listen and follow the directions of my Manager/Coach and to follow MYSA League Rules as set forth by the Board of Directors.
- **Respect my Team Members and Other Players.** I will not insult, criticize or verbally abuse any other player. Such behavior does not promote team spirit and will not be tolerated by the Manteca Youth Softball Association.
- **Physical Threats will not be Tolerated.** Manteca Youth Softball Association promotes a zero-tolerance policy on the issue of physical threats. Any occurrence will be directed to the Manager of the team. Depending on the severity, reports should then be reported to the Board of Directors of MYSA.
- **Display Good Sportsmanship.** As a representative of MYSA I will not display any behavior that will discredit myself or bring dishonor to the Manteca Youth Softball Association.
- **Be a Team Player.** It's not about winning or losing. It's about being part of a team, working together, and having fun. I promise to do my best and give 100% every time we are together as a team.
